



Pool Studies

Our pool studies are designed to provide the owner with a report that can be used to make well informed decisions as to the extent of needed alternatives and costs of renovations.

We begin with a site visit to perform a thorough inspection of the pool, natatorium and equipment room. We collect all the available existing data to include, but not necessarily be limited to, AIA drawings, "as built" drawings, daily reports, and repair and/or renovation history. We also solicit information from the owner, pool operator, lifeguards and/or interested end users as to program use, storage space, or concerns.

Once the data is collected we provide a written report that includes:

- a. A general review of the existing conditions;
- b. Note any safety hazards and/or violations of the current health code;
- c. Prioritized list of observations of items that need to be addressed;
- d. Offer recommendations, each accompanied with a line item budget; and
- e. Conclude with a summary statement.

We have successfully completed dozens of pool studies. Our experience is that the data and information provided in these studies have been helpful to owners and/or owners' representatives in making constructive and informed decisions for further action.
